

## QUALITY COMMUNITY PROGRAMS PROPOSAL SUMMARY 2010

### Safe Routes to School/ Transportation Enhancement Project:

1. **Oak Street:** Construct 1100 feet of new sidewalk on Oak Street (State Route 1A) to connect neighborhoods east of Oak Street to the new K-8 School. Safe Routes to School/Transportation Enhancement Funds are sought for this new sidewalk. Please see attached map. This project is estimated to cost \$152,000 for design, construction and oversight. Total local match at 20% would equal \$30,500.

### Related Project:

2. **Church Street:** Construct 1300 feet of new sidewalk on Church Street (local road) to connect neighborhoods to the new K-8 School. This is a related project, which will be built in conjunction with utility and road re-construction on Church Street. However, Ellsworth is not seeking Quality Community Fund reimbursement for planned city expenditures on this new sidewalk.
